Trends

- End 2023 and 2024 to date have been busy
- Complaints based on social media activity
- Complaints based on activity in non-PostgreSQL channels
- Complaints based on alleged sexual misconduct
- Complaints from several individuals about the same issue (separately or joint submission)

Opportunities

- New call for members as membership currently only at 5 individuals
- Enforcement of CoC decisions, including appeals process
- Annual training for CoCC members on investigative procedures and reporting
- Level-setting for community events regarding appropriate conduct and existence / use of CoC
- Revision of CoC Policy

CoC Policy Revision

- CoC Policy needs updating to address a number of issues:
 - Roles & responsibilities (Chair, Members, Core, investigation participants)
 - Scope of what is covered by CoC Policy (ie, what interactions, etc.)
 - Process for appealing CoC decisions
 - Record sharing and retention
 - Communication processes with complainants & respondents
 - Retaliation clause currently limited
 - Outcomes and enforcement processes

 - September 2024: New policy in effect
